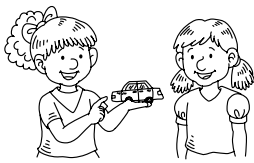
## Grammar in a Minute

We use **those** to talk about two or more things or people far from us.



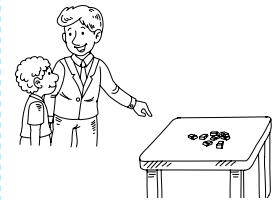
