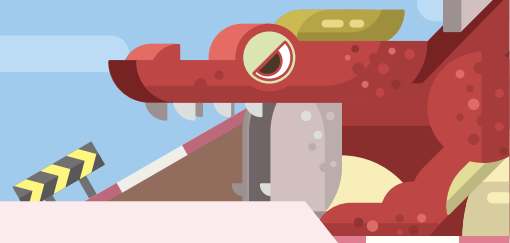

Ducks, pigs **and** cows live in farms.

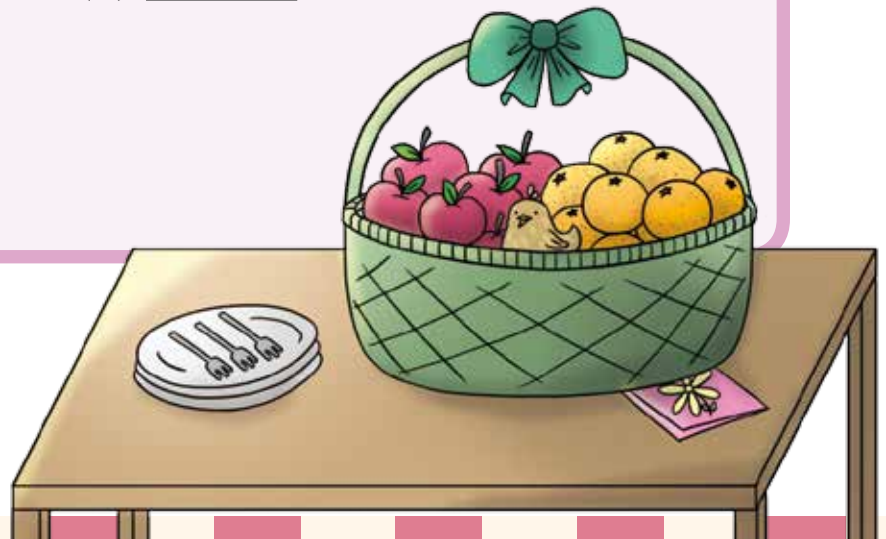
