Oh my god!

Peggy and Mary run to Katy's brick house. The wolf goes there too.

Wolf: Katy, open the door!

- 20 Katy: Go away!

The wolf is very angry! He tries hard but he cannot blow down the brick house! It is strong! Then he goes away.

- 25 Mary & Peggy: Thank you, Katy! We should be hard-working and build a brick house like you!
