And that is what changed his mind. “I realized there is a pain of having a disabled son with no limbs, but greater is the pain to have a son without limbs who commits suicide.”

Eventually coming to terms with his disability, Nick decided to become vocal about living with disabilities and finding hope and meaning in life. He chose to follow in the footsteps of God, but again, it was not always this way. He used to be furious with God. “God, if you’re real and you love me, where is my miracle?” he doubted. He even doubted if He was real. At the age of 15, God clearly answered him through John Chapter 9 about the question of why. Jesus came across a man who was born blind and Jesus said he was born that way so that the works of God would be revealed through him. And that was when he saw a glimmer of light and faith.

Now, Nick is an internationally successful motivational speaker, he has visited more than 57 countries and given over three thousand talks, some of which have attracted audiences as large as 110,000 people. may stand in their way.

What I love about this book, is the positive energy it gives me and flows through my body. I have known about this incredible man since I was 6, and his story still inspires me today.
