

Rainbow Bananas

You need:

- Two bananas (without skin)
- Some sprinkles
- Some sticks
- A piece of dark chocolate

Steps:

1. Cut the bananas into half horizontally.
2. Push a stick into each piece of bananas and put them into the refrigerator for two hours.
3. Put the chocolate in a glass bowl. Put the bowl into the microwave oven to melt the chocolate. 10
4. Dip the bananas into the melted chocolate.
5. Put the sprinkles on a plate and roll the chocolate bananas on them.

Notes:

- > Work fast on the last step. Otherwise the sprinkles cannot stick to the chocolate bananas. 15
- > Make a white rainbow banana using white chocolate if you like.
- > You can try this recipe with strawberries or apples.









