e.g. Justin is **the tallest**.

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More ... than, the most **Drill 8**

音節較長的形容詞包括三個音節或以上的形容詞，以及非 *-y* 字尾的兩個音節形容詞：

三個音節或以上的形容詞	e.g. beautiful, expensive, popular
非 <i>-y</i> 字尾的兩個音節形容詞	e.g. boring, helpful, polite

- ◆ 這些形容詞以 *more ... than* 或 *the most* 作比較
e.g. Book A is **more interesting than** Book B.
Book C is **the most interesting**.
Sally is **more hardworking than** Fred.
Charles is **the most hardworking** student in our class.

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1 比較級和最高級形容詞 Comparative and superlative adjectives

音節較短的形容詞：

- Ethan is more fat than Rosy.
- Ethan is fatter than Rosy.

音節較長的形容詞：

1. Shop C is the most colourfulest.
- Shop C is the most colourful.
2. Shop A is more famous than shop.
- Shop A is the most famous shop.

解構

先辨識形容詞音節來判斷其轉法。fat 是單音節形容詞，比較時不加 more，而是根據其字尾轉為 **fatter**。

解構

題 1 的 colourful 在加上 the most 後不用再加上 -est，因此答案是 **the most colourful**；題 2 句尾的 shop 是表示 Shop A 的類型，並不是與 Shop A 同等的比較項目，所以應用最高級形容詞 **the most famous**。

向扣分 say NO!

- 當比較相同物品時，可以 's 省略第二次出現的物品。

Amy's bag is heavier than Tom's. (Tom's 等於 Tom's bag)

- 留意不要混淆 then 和 than。

- Jackie's book is thicker **then** John's.
- Jackie's book is thicker **than** John's.

- 最高級形容詞後面可以不加名詞，但前面必須加上 **the**。

Natalie is **the** tallest (girl).
