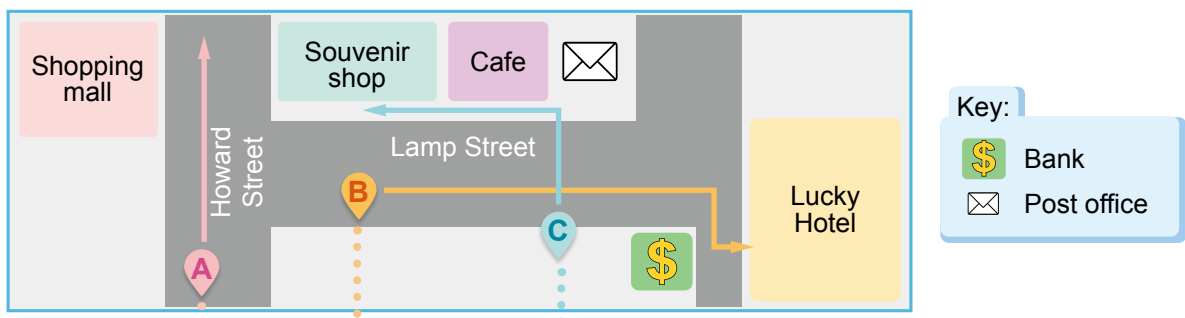

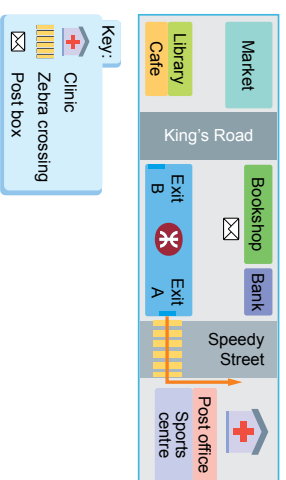

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## Too many, too much **Drill 8**

用 too many / too much 表示數量太多。

- ◆ too many 後接可數名詞，名詞要轉為複數

e.g. The bag is heavy. There are too many apples inside.

There are too many shops in the mall. We can't go them all.

- ◆ too much 後接不可數名詞

e.g. Don't eat too much chocolate. It's not good for your health.

There is too much salt in the soup. It is very salty.

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# Grammar 文法

## 常犯錯誤大解構

### 1 A lot of, a few, a little

- ✗ We ate (i) a few chocolate (chocolate) and (ii) a little pineapples (pineapples).
- ✓ We ate (i) a little chocolate (chocolate) and (ii) a few pineapples (pineapples).

#### 解構

題目中 chocolate 是不可數名詞，所以要用 **a little**，而 pineapples 是可數名詞，因此答案是 **a few**。

### 向扣分 say NO!

當以量詞 (如 **a lot of / a few / too many / more / fewer**) 形容可數名詞的數量時，名詞要轉為複數。

There are **a lot of** apples in the basket.

Put **a few** cherries on the cake.

### 2 So, because

1. ✗ Alice had the piano lesson today because she left early.  
✓ Alice had the piano lesson today so she left early.
2. ✗ Sam did not join the match so he was absent from school.  
✓ Sam did not join the match because he was absent from school.

#### 解構

先辨識前後句子的因果關係，題 1 中，had the piano lesson today (上鋼琴課) 是 Alice left early (早走) 的原因，因此應用 **so** (所以)；題 2 中，did not join the match (沒有參加比賽) 是 Sam was absent from school (缺席) 的結果，所以答案是 **because** (因為)。

### 向扣分 say NO!

雖然中文有「因為……所以」的句式結構，但在英文文法上，**because** 和 **so** 不能一同使用。

- ✗ **Because** Tim is starving **so** he is going to eat five hamburgers.
- ✓ Tim is starving **so** he is going to eat five hamburgers.
- ✓ Tim is going to eat five hamburgers **because** he is starving.
