## How to make use of food waste?

## Eggshells

Do you know eggshells can be a powerful fertilizer for growing plants? Eggshell fertilizer is made from crushed eggshells, which are high in calcium carbonate. It is an important mineral for strengthening plants' roots. Besides, eggshells can lower soil acidity to help plants absorb nutrients and control pests. To make this effective and cheap fertilizer, simply crush the eggshells into powder and stir it into your potting mix. Isn't it simple? Let's give it a try.

## Orange peels

Have you ever got coffee stains in your mug? Now, here is a quick and easy way to solve this problem. To remove the coffee stains, put salt on orange peels and rub them on the stains for a few minutes. Then, rinse the mug with water and drain it before you dry it with a cloth. Apart from removing stains, orange peels can remove a strong coffee smell by giving a natural fruity aroma. Next time, try to use orange peels to clean your mug!

## Coffee grounds

Do you usually throw away the grounds after making coffee? Coffee grounds can be used as a natural cleaning scrub to clean surfaces. The antibacterial properties can help sanitise as well. If you do not like to clean with chemicals, you can try to rub your sink, polish your cookware, or clean your grill with coffee grounds. However, remember not to use them on porous surfaces as they may cause brown stains.

## End of the bread

After opening, a packet of brown sugar soon turns into a rock-solid block. If you want to prevent brown sugar from hardening, you can stick a piece of bread in your brown sugar container once you have opened it. It doesn't matter what kind of bread you use. A little end of the bread will do. It can give the brown sugar just enough moisture to prevent it from turning hard. Sounds easy? You should try it next time.
